A LITTLE DIFFERENT



POTTSTOWN — Once the site of the dilapidated Little's Bar, the corner of Walnut and Washington streets is now home to some new homes, the latest in Genesis Housing Corp.'s ongoing efforts to refurbish and build new affordable housing in the core of Pottstown's oldest areas. The four new semi-detached homes have three bedrooms, one-and-a-half baths, a front porch, Hardiplank siding and a landscaped yard. The homes will be sold to eligible first-time buyers and the monthly housing payment is estimated at less than \$825 per month for principal, interest, taxes and insurance. Buyers must have good credit, a 3 percent down payment and earn less than 80 percent of the median income. For a family of two, the maximum income is \$46,150. For a family of three, the maximum income is \$51,950. Interested buyers should call Nikki Holcroft at 610-275-4357.
